EuBike project has come to its end in June, finalized during its Final Conference "On Cycling, Sharing and Creating", which took place in Vienna, Austria on 22 June 2016. In addition to the EuBike final products from every project pilot region, a number of local and international initiatives related to cycling have been presented during the event. The final conference was combined with the EuBike Austria Networking Event
